

BRC Competition Passes

Beginning with the winter qualifiers, all riders at qualifiers and championships will need to have current, valid membership and a valid competition pass. The competition pass replaces pre-entries.

The pass will be ready for purchase via Sport:80 ([Britishridingclubs.sport80.com](https://britishridingclubs.sport80.com)) by early September ready for the start of winter qualifiers taking place from October 2025 for the 2026 Championships.

The competition passes will be £30 plus transaction fee (for riders competing 1-2 horses) and £45 plus transaction fee (for riders competing 3 or more horses) for a rolling 12 months. Horses do not need to be registered.

Members must have a valid club membership and valid competition pass at time of competing; the onus is on the rider to ensure they have up-to-date memberships. **Failure to have valid memberships could result in elimination.**

Eligibility will be taken from the competition date for both horses and riders.

Q: What happens if I purchase a competition pass and I decide not to compete? *Refunds will be granted for the competition passes, if requested, for up to seven days after the purchase date, provided the member has not attended a qualifier or championship. This is at the discretion of BRC. The transaction fee is non-refundable.*

Q: Can I upgrade or downgrade my competition pass throughout the year? *Riders will be able to upgrade their competition pass to 3 or more horses at any point in the year, but riders will not be able to downgrade their pass until renewal. Where riders who have a 2-horse pass sell a horse and purchase a new one, they will not need to upgrade their pass as only competing 2 horses at a time. If a rider owns 3 horses and competes those horses across the year, even if they only ever have 2 horses at a qualifier at a time, they will need the 3 or more horse pass. Exceptions will be granted for one-off use of another horse where lameness has occurred, and when a horse is borrowed for one competition.*

The competition pass covers riders whether they are part of a team, a pair or an individual.

The competition pass covers all BRC disciplines across BRC Qualifiers and Championships including Quadrille and allows the holder to enter as many classes as they wish at their area qualifiers.

A competition pass is not required for Blenheim Challenge, Hickstead Teams of 3 and e-Riders.
